When can I sign up?

You will receive notice of a General Assembly of Parents from your school principal or the Chair of the Governing Board (GB). The parent representatives on the GB are elected at this meeting held in

September.

By September 30 each year, the Governing Board is up and running.

What's the term of office?

The term of office of the parent representatives on the GB is two years. There are at least five meetings a year.

At the GB the following people work together to build a school that best meets the needs of its students:

At least four parents

At least four members of the school staff: teachers, non-teaching professionals, and support staff

Two students from Cycle 2 secondary, where applicable

One childcare representative, where applicable

Two community representatives

The school principal
