Dear Parents,

I am writing to you today to let you know that unfortunately we have a student with a confirmed case of H1N1. The student, who is recuperating and is a member of Ms.Greenwood's K class as well as a traveler on bus #56 & #70, was in school on October 22<sup>nd</sup> (and in Daycare on October 23<sup>rd</sup>) and then developed a fever. It appears that the incubation period may be as short as four days, therefore we are monitoring our students very carefully.

As you have been told previously, we are regularly disinfecting at school. Today we increased our efforts and we will continue to do all we can in terms of prevention. As we are following the directives of both the School Board and the Ministry, an isolation area has been set up for anyone showing symptoms.

At this time, we are especially looking for your support. If your child has a fever, please be sure to keep him/her at home. If you receive a phone call from the school letting you know that your child has developed a fever (rapid onset of fever is an important symptom) please do all you can to pick your child up as soon as possible. These efforts are very important to prevention.
