A Message from the CSSS-IUGS Intended for the Parents of Children attending a Primary School in Sherbrooke

There is only one A (H1N1) vaccination centre in Sherbrooke and it is located at Terrasses Rock Forest at 4857 Bourque Boulevard. Children aged 5 to 12 years can get their vaccine at that location. As no bus service is available to them, it is up to the parents to ensure their transportation to the vaccination centre.

Good news!

In order to facilitate access of children aged 5 to 12 years, the CSSS-IUGS is offering parents the possibility to obtain admission coupons to the vaccination centre in advance for November 19, 20, 21 and 22.

Beginning in the morning of November 19, parents can go to any of the coupon distribution centres to obtain an admission coupon which potentially suits their schedule for the very same day; Friday, November 20 (pedagogical day); Saturday, November 21, or Sunday, November 22.

The vaccination centre will be open according to the following schedule:

Days	Schedule
November 19	1 p.m. to 8 p.m.
November 20, 21 and 22	8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Three hundred to 400 admission coupons are available for each opening hour of the vaccination centre.

You can obtain an admission coupon with appointment for your children as well as those of your friends and family. If you are not accompanying your child to the vaccination centre, you must give his admission ticket to the person accompanying him along with a written authorization. This can be a letter containing the vaccination date, the name of the child, and the name of the A (H1N1) vaccine. You can also download an authorization form on the homepage of the CSSS-IUGS web portal at www.csss-iugs.ca.

Vaccination remains the most effective public health measure to counter the ongoing flu pandemic. We strongly recommend that you have your child vaccinated.
