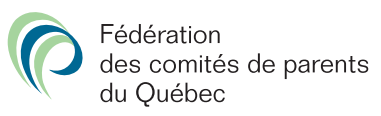

Join your school's PPO or create one!

What is a Parent Participation Organization (PPO)?

The PPO is reserved for parents only, parents who care about student success and want to be part of school life. PPO parents :

- are involved in drafting, carrying out and evaluating the school's educational project;
- give their opinion on the improvements that should be made in the school;
- carry out various projects and activities in tandem with school staff.

HOW IS A PPO CREATED?

When?

At the annual assembly of parents in September.

How?

The people at the annual assembly choose the name, composition, and rules of the PPO. PPO members are elected at this meeting.

What then?

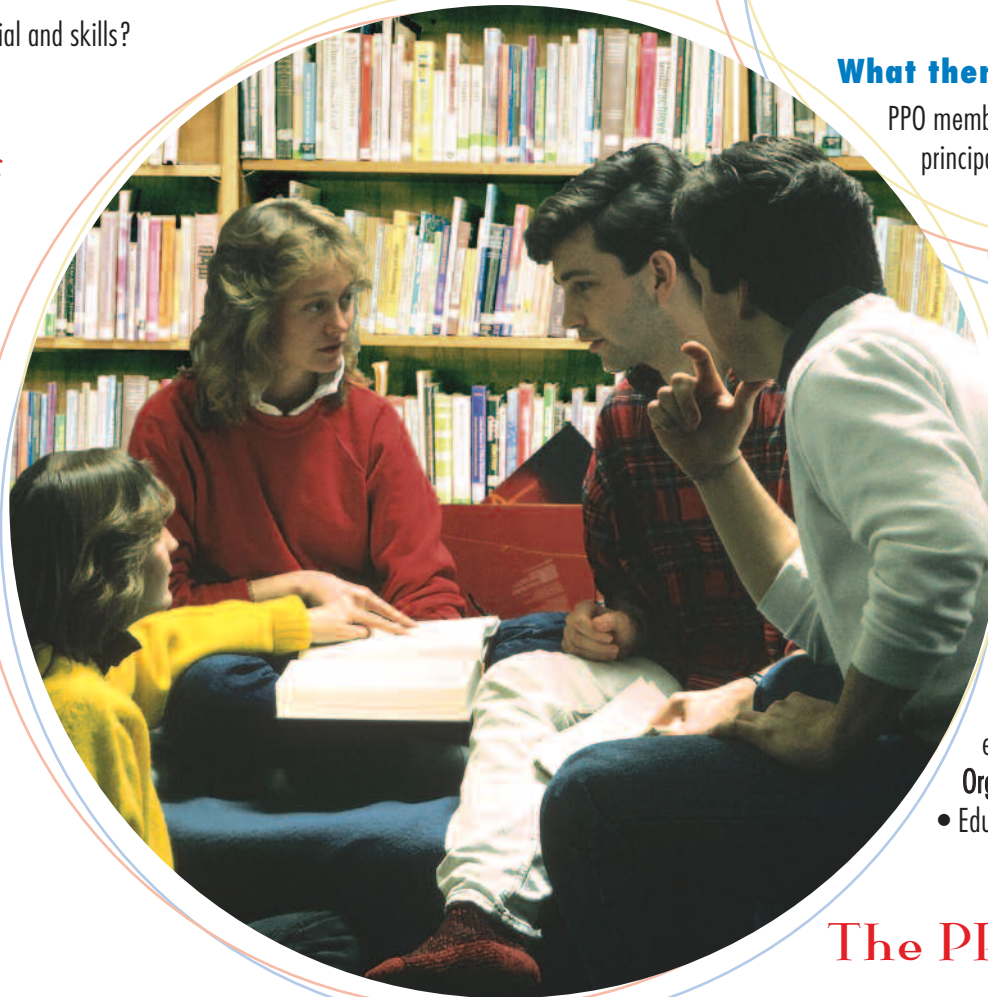
PPO members meet at the school and work with the principal to determine a work plan.

The general assembly can form:

- One PPO for each immovable, if the school has more than one
- One PPO for each level of instruction, if the school offers elementary and secondary instruction.
