Students' Code of Conduct On the Use of Computer resources

(Elementary)

The Internet is made available to students by the school to encourage their learning. Using it is a privilege, not a right. - I will not send or knowingly receive text, images or sounds that are obscene, insulting or rude.
- I will not go to a meeting with anybody that I planned through the Internet unless my parents have given me permission.
- I will be careful and will not buy anything on the Internet without my parent's permission.
- I will not use an Internet chat, discussion or news group without permission and supervision by an adult from the school.

I won't believe everything I read on the Internet.

> when I'm using e-mail

- I won't send e-mail messages at school without my teacher's permission and supervision.
- I won't answer any message that makes me feel uncomfortable. If I get that kind of message, I will show it to an adult right away.
- I won't open e-mail messages from people I don't know or trust. I will always ask permission to do so from an adult first.
- I will not give my e-mail password to anyone.

> I will also be careful of security and protecting the computers

- I won't bring any diskettes to school without my teacher's permission and I won't download any file that I think might have a virus.
- I won't try to open or read anybody else's files without their permission.
- I won't change any files that don't belong to me.
- I will tell a teacher or the school principal or secretary about any vandalism or threat to computer security that I am aware of.
- I won't open any e-mail attachment that I receive unless I know exactly what it is and where it came from.

If I don't use the school's computers correctly, I may not be allowed to use them or the Internet again, and I may be disciplined according to the school's rules of conduct, depending on how serious my actions are.

I have read and I understand the school's rules for using its computers and the Internet, and I agree to follow them.
