#### NATURE OF THE WORK

The position of Education Consultant encompasses, in particular, responsibility for providing advice and support to staff of educational institutions and services in the research, development, implementation, and evaluation of educational programs, class management and instructional materials. The Education Consultant will work under the supervision of the Director of Pedagogical Services and with the pedagogical consultants' team to accomplish the following in relation to his/her subject area:

- Support the development and implementation of the ETSB Strategic Plan, its pillars, and ETSB policies in the domains specific to the subject area, and this will be done in collaboration with other consultants and professionals
- Demonstrate a good understanding of the Quebec Education Program, Frameworks for the Evaluation of Learning, and Progression of Learning
- Provide leadership and assistance to teachers and other personnel concerned in the subject area
- Organize and deliver professional development activities to teachers and staff on current best practices in the subject area, model lessons in the classroom, and analyze/interpret data collected to make recommendations to the school team and Director of Pedagogical Services
- Provide advice and support to teachers and other staff concerned, either individually or in a group format, in matters pertaining to daily teaching activities, instructional practices, or professional improvement programs
- Develop or select and deliver training and instrumentation activities designed to respond to needs in pedagogical adaptation, innovation and development
- Keep abreast of research and new developments in the fields of the subject area and high-yielding instructional strategies, especially with respect to curricula, educational methods, complementary activities, programs and educational materials and evaluation of academic performance
- Model rich integration of technology within the subject area (eg deepen integration as per the SAMR model)
- Facilitate the development, distribution and implementation of formative and summative assessments, as well as common board and provincial assessments
- Analyze and recommend the purchase of learning materials, supplementary materials, equipment, software and program packages, and provide advice on room layouts
- Represent the school board in relevant MEES and regional meetings and participate in school board meetings such as: Pedagogical Services, Principals' Tables (when necessary), Educational Services Advisory Committee (when necessary) and inter-board committees
- Any other related tasks as assigned by the consultant's supervisor.


