Science Fair success at Massey Vanier

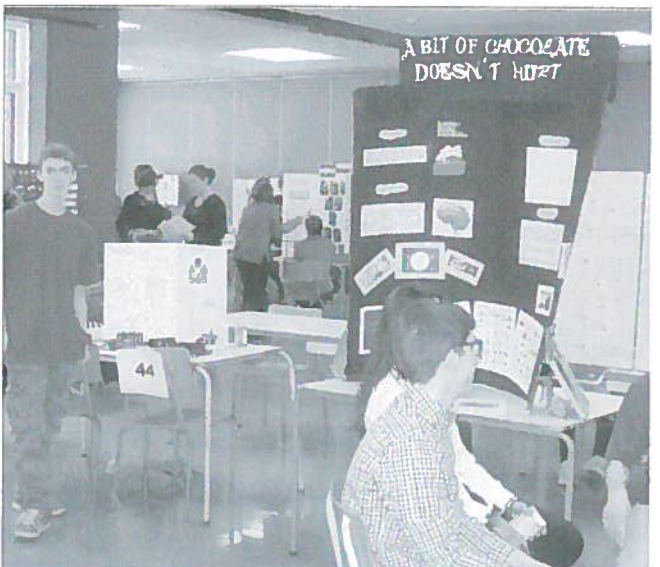
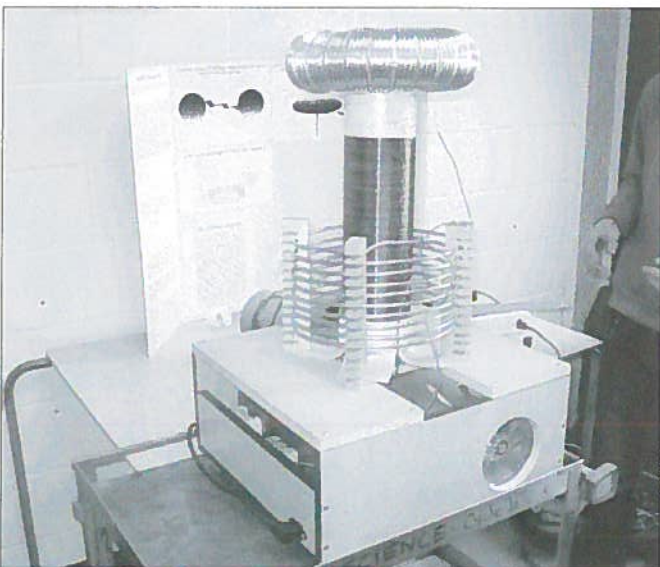
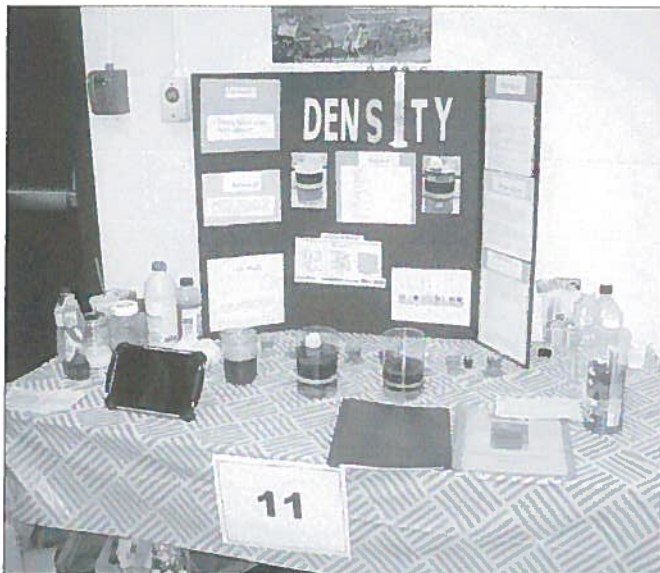
