Conditions of eligibility

Act respecting school elections to elect certain members of the boards of directors of English-language school service centres (sections 20 to 21.4)

- **20.** Every person who, on polling day, meets the following conditions may be elected to a parent representative seat on an English-language school service centre's board of directors:
 - 1° be the parent of a child referred to in section 1 of the *Education Act* (chapter I-13.3) and admitted to educational services provided by the school service centre;
 - 2° be entitled to have his name entered on the school service centre's list of electors;
 - 3° have been domiciled in the school service centre's territory for six months or more; and
 - 4° sit as a parent representative on the governing board of a school or of a vocational training centre that is under the jurisdiction of the school service centre or as a parent representative on the school service centre's board of directors.
- **20.1** Every person who, on polling day, meets the following conditions may be elected to a community representative seat on an English-language school service centre's board of directors:
 - 1º be entitled to have his name entered on the school service centre's list of electors;
 - 2º have been domiciled in the school service centre's territory for six months or more; and
 - 3° meet the profile set out in subparagraph 2 of the first paragraph of section 143.1 of the *Education Act* (chapter I-13.3), for the seat for which he is running.
- **21.** The following persons are disqualified for election to the office of elected member of an English-language school service centre's board of directors:
 - 1° Members of the National Assembly;
 - 2° Members of the Parliament of Canada;
 - 2.1° municipal council members;
 - 3° justices of any court of justice;
 - 3.1° the chief electoral officer and the other members of the Commission de la représentation;
 - 3.2° public servants, except employees within the meaning of the Labour Code (chapter C-27), of the Ministère de l'Éducation, du Loisir et du Sport or of any other department who are assigned to the Ministère de l'Éducation, du Loisir et du Sport on a permanent basis;
 - 4° an employee of the English-language school service centre;
 - 4.1° election officers of the English-language school service centre;
 - 5° a person sentenced to imprisonment.
 - Disqualification under subparagraph 5 applies for the term of the sentence but ceases if the person obtains a pardon for the offence committed.
 - Employees of the Comité de gestion de la taxe scolaire de l'île de Montréal are disqualified for election to the office of elected member of an English-language school service centre's board of directors on the island of Montréal.
- **21.1** Any candidate at a previous election whose financial report or return of election expenses required under any of sections 206.10, 206.13, 209, 209.3 and 209.4 has not been transmitted within the prescribed time is ineligible until the report or return is transmitted.
- **21.2** Any candidate at a previous election who has not paid in full the debts arising from his election expenses in accordance with section 206.56 is ineligible for four years from his default.
 - Notwithstanding the foregoing, the ineligibility affecting an elected candidate shall cease on the day of the transmission of the financial report establishing that the debts have been paid in full where the transmission occurs before the expiry of the four-year period.

- **21.3** A person is ineligible for office as a member of an English-language school service centre's board of directors if he holds office as member of the board of another English-language school service centre or if he is a candidate for such an office.
 - Any person who is already holding an office on an English-language school service centre's board of directors is also ineligible for office as a member of the board, except in the event of an election at which the office held by the person is open for nominations or ceases to exist.
- **21.4** A person is ineligible for office as a member of an English-language school service centre's board of directors if, following a judgment that has become *res judicata*, he is disqualified under section 176 of the *Education Act* (chapter I-13.3).

Education Act (section 143.1 (1), 2°)

143.1 An English-language school service centre shall be administered by a board of directors composed of the following members:

[...]

- 2° between 4 and 13 community representatives who are domiciled in the school service centre's territory and who are not members of the school service centre's staff, including
 - a) at least one person with expertise in governance, in ethics, in risk management or in human resources management;
 - b) at least one person with expertise in finance or accounting or in financial or physical resources management;
 - c) at least one person from the community, municipal, sport, cultural, health, social services or business sector; and
 - d) at least one person aged 18 to 35
