4.2 <u>Council of Commissioners – Vice-chair election (section 155.1)</u>

155.1. The council of commissioners shall appoint, from among its members, the vice-chair of the school board.

The term of office of the vice-chair, unless removed by a vote of not less than two-thirds of the members of the council of commissioners who are entitled to vote, expires at the same time as the vice-chair's term as commissioner.

4.3 Advisory committees

4.3.1 Resolution No. ETSB 20-11-24 Committees' Structure

WHEREAS section 193.1 of the *Education Act* (EA) requires that the Council of Commissioners must establish the following committees:

- ✓ a Governance and Ethics Committee:
- ✓ an Audit Committee; and
- ✓ a Human Resources Committee.

WHEREAS section 185 of the *Education Act* requires that every school board shall establish an Advisory Committee on services for handicapped students and students with social maladjustments or learning disabilities;

WHEREAS section 188 of the *Education Act* requires that every school board which provides student transportation shall establish an Advisory Committee on Transportation. The composition, operation and functions of which shall meet the norms established by government regulation;

WHEREAS section 193.1 of the *Education Act* stipulates that the Council of Commissioners may establish other committees to assist it in the exercise of its functions or the examination of specific matters;

WHEREAS following discussions, the Eastern Townships School Board wants some additional committees, such as Communications and Educational Services;

WHEREAS each of these committees will have to elect a Chairperson;

WHEREAS the Chairperson of the school board is already part of the Executive Committee (EA section 179);

WHEREAS at least one Commissioner representing parents must be part of the Executive Committee (EA section 179);

WHEREAS if no Commissioners representing parents have been elected as a Chair of an Advisory Committee, a Commissioner representing parents must be elected by their peers to be part of the Executive Committee;

WHEREAS the term of Office of Members on the Executive Committee be one (1) year (EA section 179);

IT WAS MOVED BY Commissioner T. Pezzi-Bilodeau that the Executive Committee will be established with the elected Advisory Committee Chairs including the Chairperson of the School Board and at least one Commissioner representing parents.

4.3.2 Resolution No. ETSB 20-11-25 Adoption of Election Process

IT WAS MOVED BY Commissioner G. Holliday that the following procedure for the election of a member as Vice-Chairman and members of the Executive Committee.

A President of Elections and two scrutineers shall be chosen by members of the Council of Commissioners.

If more than the required number of candidates is nominated, an election shall be held by secret ballot.

Nominations: Nominees can nominate themselves or be nominated by someone else.

Adoption of a proposal to end the nominations.

The President of Elections verifies with each nominee in reverse order of the nomination if they accept to run as a candidate.

If there is more than one candidate, an election shall be held by secret ballot.

The candidate with the most votes will be declared elected.

Immediately following the reading of the results, the ballots shall be destroyed.

4.4 Appeal committee (as per ETSB Policy P023-1)

By virtue of section 11 of the *Education Act*, the Council establishes an Appeal Committee composed of five members and substitutes it appoints annually.

4.4.1 <u>Establishment and Composition of the Appeal Committee</u>

As per the ETSB Policy P023-1, the establishment and composition of the Appeal Committee is the following:

- ➤ Three Commissioners elected or appointed pursuant to the *Act respecting school elections* (R.S.Q., c. E-2.3);
- One Commissioner representing Parents;
- > One Administrator of the Board (school, centre or central office Administrator), not affiliated with the school/centre concerned.

4.4.2 <u>Term of Office Members</u>

According to the *Education Act*, the Term of Office of Members on the Appeal Committee will be one (1) year.

4.6 **Buildings & Grounds**

4.6.1 Resolution No. ETSB 20-11-28 2020-2021 Investment project proposal

WHEREAS with this measure the *ministère de l'Éducation et de l'Enseignement supérieur* (*MEES*) aims at financing work in order to maintain and/or renovate all of the School Board's buildings dedicated to educational and administrative purposes;

WHEREAS the Eastern Townships School Board has prepared a priority list of investment projects to be proposed to the *ministère de l'Éducation et de l'Enseignement supérieur (MEES)* for authorization according to the program *Maintien des bâtiments 2020-2021 (Mesure 50621)*, to the program *Résorption du déficit de maintien 2020-2021 (Mesure 50622)*;

WHEREAS this list must be sent to the *ministère de l'Éducation et de l'Enseignement supérieur (MEES)* by the Eastern Townships School Board;

WHEREAS the said list of the proposed priorities could be subject to adjustments following possible events;

IT WAS MOVED by Commissioner J. Humenuik that the Council of Commissioners approve the priority list of projects proposed under the program *Maintien des bâtiments 2020-2021* (Mesure 50621), the program Résorption du déficit de maintien 2020-2021 (Mesure 50622).

Carried unanimously

The director general, M. Soucy presented the following resolution:

4.6.2 Resolution No. ETSB 20-11-29 <u>Sutton Elementary School – Replacement of Bus Parking Lot Pavement and</u> Storm Drainage System

WHEREAS the *ministère de l'Éducation et de l'Enseignement supérieur* (MEES) approved a budget of \$416,329 for the project stated above, under the program *MDB - Maintien des bâtiments - Budget additionnel 2018-19 Mesure : 50625*;

WHEREAS it was moved by Resolution #E20-01-48, on January 28th 2020, that a company known today as *Excavation Désourdy* be awarded a contract in the amount of \$518,134, including professional fees and taxes, for the project stated above;

WHEREAS during the project some modifications for additional work needed to be done;

WHEREAS the amount of \$77,686 to pay for all modification orders, additional work and professional fees (including taxes), is required to finish the project;

WHEREAS the total amount for the contract including all modification orders, additional work, and professional fees (including taxes), adds up to \$595,820;

WHEREAS all additional funds required to complete the project will be taken from *MDB* - *Maintien des bâtiments 2018-19* program;

IT WAS MOVED BY Commissioner R. Gagnon to proceed with the work for the project stated above; IT WAS FURTHER MOVED that the Director General be authorized to sign all associated documentation and that in the absence of the Director General, the Director of Material Resources can also sign.

4.6.3 Resolution No. ETSB 20-11-30 Sunnyside Elementary School – Replacement of Bus Parking Lot Pavement and Storm Drainage System

WHEREAS the *ministère de l'Éducation et de l'Enseignement supérieur (MEES)* approved a budget of \$371,861 for the project stated above, under the program *MDB - Maintien des bâtiments 2019-20 Mesure : 50621*;

WHEREAS it was moved by Resolution #E20-05-87, on May 26th 2020, that a company known today as *Les Entreprises Richard Brisson inc.* be awarded a contract in the amount of 399,778\$, including professional fees and taxes, for the project stated above;

WHEREAS during the project some modifications for additional work needed to be done;

WHEREAS the amount of \$66,589 to pay for all modification orders, additional work and professional fees (including taxes), is required to finish the project;

WHEREAS the total amount for the contract including all modification orders, additional work, and professional fees (including taxes), adds up to \$466,367;

WHEREAS all additional funds required to complete the project will be taken from *MDB* - *Maintien des bâtiments 2019-20* program;

IT WAS MOVED BY Commissioner C. Beaubien to proceed with the work for the project stated above; IT WAS FURTHER MOVED that the Director General be authorized to sign all associated documentation and that in the absence of the Director General, the Director of Material Resources can also sign.

4.7 Resolution No. ETSB 20-11-31 Modified 2020-2021 School Calendar

WHEREAS the Eastern Townships School Board (ETSB) 2020-2021 Youth Sector School Calendar was adopted by Resolution number 20-03-74 at the Council of Commissioners on March 24, 2020;

WHEREAS on October 29, 2020, the Ministère *de l'éducation du Québec (MEQ)* announced the amendment of the Basic School Regulation from 180 to 177 school days;

WHEREAS this Basic School Regulation amendment adds planning and training days in the youth sector for specific training in teaching strategies in an online environment;

WHEREAS the *MEQ* instructions state "to assist parents in planning for these three (3) pedagogical days, schools must provide free daycare services to all the children regularly enrolled in them";

WHEREAS to modify the existing ETSB 2020-2021 School Calendar, the consultation process with the Central Parents' Committee, the Central Student Advisory Committee, the Eastern Townships Association of Administrators, the Management Committee, the Special Education Advisory Committee, the *Syndicat des Professionnels des Commissions scolaires de l'Estrie*, the Teacher Advisory Committee, and the Townships Regional Union of Support Staff was followed;

IT WAS MOVED BY Commissioner R. Gagnon that the Council of Commissioners approve the modified 2020-2021 Eastern Townships School Board Youth Sector School Calendar as follows:

- 1. Due to the exceptional times we are living, the ETSB will place (2) movable pedagogical days (snow days) on November 23rd and December 7th 2020, from January 25th and March 26th 2021;
- 2. To assist parents in adjusting for these two (2) pedagogical days, schools will consult their respective governing boards to decide on the offer of daycare services for all children regularly enrolled in them;
- 3. The three days of training in distance education skills mandated by the Minister be placed on January 25th, February 15th and March 26th 2021.

Commissioner D. Zigby mentioned that the Central Parents' Committee (CPC) had reserves for the content of this resolution, especially for parents who might not be able to take a day off in order to watch their children.
