

# In orange zones: At school, I protect myself and others!

## Legend

These guidelines only apply to individuals in educational institutions located in orange zones.

Elementary students must wear a face covering.

Individuals must wear a procedural mask (or a pediatric procedural mask).

Individuals may remove their face covering or procedural mask (or a pediatric procedural mask).

1. These guidelines do not apply to preschool students.

2. The creation of groups with students from different class groups should be limited as much as possible. If this is not possible, a 2-metre physical distance should be maintained between students, and a physical barrier should be used to separate students from different class groups. However, if respecting this measure would entail isolating students, students may be grouped together within a "stable daycare group." When this cannot be respected, Elementary Cycle One and Two students should wear a face covering.

3. Mixing different class groups is still not permitted during physical activities. Students must not remove their masks when another class group is present, even if a physical distance of 2 metres is maintained.

4. Students from one stable class group may perform in front of an audience that consists of students from ONE other stable class group only.

Rules pertaining to face coverings and procedural masks complement the other health measures in place
