

HORATIO ALGER CANADIAN SCHOLARSHIPS

Do you know of any Grade 11 students who wish to pursue post-secondary education, but are struggling to find the financial means to do so? The Horatio Alger Association of Canada offers 10 scholarships in the amount of \$10,000 and 150 scholarships in the amount of \$5,000 to support students experiencing financial need.

As you share our scholarship with students who qualify, please note that these scholarships are only open to students currently in Grade 11. The goal is to support future scholarship recipients in CEGEP/Grade 12 as they prepare to transition to University. The deadline to apply is March 15, 2023, no later than 12 p.m. EST.

Eligibility

To be eligible to apply for the Horatio Alger Canadian Scholarship, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be enrolled full-time as a high school Grade 11 or first-year CEGEP student in Canada;
- Exhibit a strong commitment to pursue and complete a bachelor's degree program at an accredited university;
- Prove critical financial need (\$65,000 or less annual net income per family is required);
- Demonstrate desire and ability to be entrepreneurial in a chosen field;
- Be involved in co-curricular and community service activities;
- Display integrity and perseverance in overcoming adversity;
- Maintain a minimum grade percentage of 70;
- Be a Canadian citizen.
