

School Board Elections 2024

DIVISION OF TERRITORY INTO ELECTORAL WARDS

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that the Council of Commissioners of the Eastern Townships School Board has adopted a division proposal of the territory of the School Board into eleven (11) electoral divisions for the purpose of the 2024 school board elections.

Any persons wishing to examine the electoral divisions may do so by presenting themselves at the Administrative Office of the school board situated at 340, Saint-Jean-Bosco, Magog, (Québec), between the hours of 9:00 a.m.to 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. from Monday to Friday until June 22, 2023 or on the Eastern Townships School Board website at http://www.etsb.qc.ca/.

Any objections to the division proposal must be submitted in writing to the Returning Officer within 15 days of the publication of this notice at 340, Saint-Jean-Bosco, Magog (Québec) J1X 1K9, or by email at secgen@etsb.qc.ca. If the number of objections reaches 100, the Council of Commissioners is obliged to hold a public meeting to hear the persons present in respect of the division proposal.


