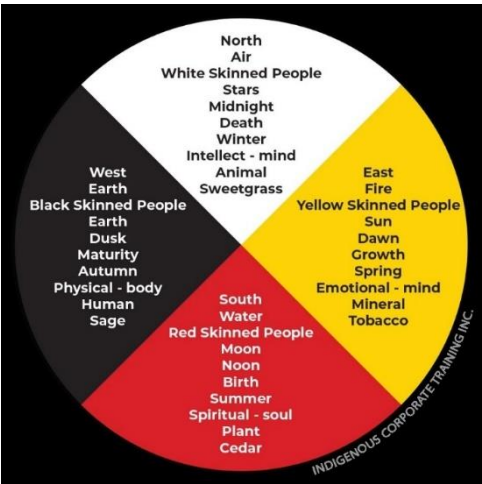
IPAM (Indigenous Peoples Awareness Month)
